This year the OIH staff would like to remind and introduce an exciting program to all our old and new sponsors, donors, organizations, church leaders and pastors, community service leaders or missions committee in order to show our love to many destitute children in Haiti. The program is: *Love Parcel*. It is specifically designed to show thousands of poverty stricken children in Haiti and around the world how much we care about them and keep them constantly in our prayers.

What is a Love Parcel?

The *Love Parcel* program consists of a large towel that is filled with items such as soap, toothbrush, shampoo, clothing, etc. It provides a wonderful gift to those kids who have absolutely nothing. Each *Love Parcel* puts a smile on a child's face and shows to them the true love of Christ. Has God impressed you to donate a certain item such as toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner, lotion, combs or other objects to be included in the parcels that are made up in our warehouse?

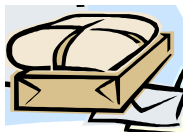
Love Parcel Instructions

- 1.) Follow the guidelines of things to pack inside.
- 2.) Lay a large towel out flat. Place the items in the middle of the towel and then fold the towel up to hold the items inside. Pin the towel in a blue plastic Wal-Mart bag.
- 3.) **Fill out a love Parcel envelope and enclose a check for \$5.00 for each parcel packed. Place the envelope inside a plastic bag. Please remember that EVERY PARCEL must have an envelope.**

For more than one parcel, photocopy the envelope and place a copy in each bag. One check may then be placed in the main envelope for the entire number of parcels prepared. If you are sending several parcels, one check for each parcel shipped will do (10 parcels x \$5 = \$ 50 check). The \$5.00 covers all shipping cost from our warehouse in Haiti.

The shipping fee must be included for all parcels sent or your parcel cannot be sent to the mission in Haiti. Make your check payable to OIH.

- 5.) **Parcels must be in Margate, Florida by November 1, 2007 in order to ship to Haiti.**

DO NOT SEND: Used clothing, toy guns, knives or war related items, money, your address, perishable items. We are asking that you DO NOT SEND any food (except a jar of peanut butter) or candy because this results in a problem with drawing bugs and rodents into our warehouses. If you are fixing a box for 3 year old, then purchase size 3- a 6 year old then purchase size 6 and so on. Please do not send winter or heavy clothing, as the climate in Haiti is very warm.
