WELL DRILLING EQUIPMENT

The OIH well drilling equipment is sitting in Holland, Michigan, waiting to make its pilgrimage to Bombardopolis, Haiti. This undertaking will not be financially or logistically easy. The expected cost to ship the rig via container is approximately \$10,000 USD. Once it arrives in Haiti we will have custom fees and then the cost of driving it up to Bombardopolis. It is expected to be a two-day challenging drive to Bombardopolis from Port-au-Prince. The dream of having potable water at our facility is becoming a reality for our OIH children and we thank God for all of you who have made this happen. The Lord has provided up to this point, and we are sure that He has a plan for the rest of this project.

PLEASE DO NOT SEND

Worn out used clothing, toy guns, knives or war-related items, money, your address, perishable items. We are asking that you **DO NOT SEND** any food (except a jar of peanut butter) or candy because this results in a problem with drawing bugs and rodents into our warehouse.

LOVE PARCEL PACKING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Lay a large towel flat. Place your items in the middle of the towel. Fold the towel up to hold the items inside and then pin the towel together and place in a large plastic shopping bag.
2. Fill out a LOVE PARCEL envelope. Place your check, payable to "OIH," for the total amount of shipping in the envelope. Please send \$5 for each parcel you want to send. **EVERY** parcel **MUST** have an envelope, or copy of envelope, inside. When shipping more than one parcel, photocopy the envelope and place a photocopy of the envelope in each additional parcel. Place the envelope, with the check, inside one of the large plastic shopping bags. The \$5 charge covers all shipping costs from our warehouse in Haiti to our orphanage. The shipping fee **MUST** be included for all parcels sent or your parcel will not be forwarded on to the mission in Haiti. Ship your parcel(s) to:
